Rules & Responsibilities of POC
(Person of Contact)

Arrange reservations for restaurant and/or place of activity. Contact Planning Chairperson to reserve rooms in Parish Center. Notify Planning Chairperson of any cancellations and/or changes in events.

Receive phone calls from participants. Notify participants of changes and/or cancellations, etc.

Attend your activity and be prompt & courteous.

Take responsibility for event content and behavior of your participants.

Report any significant incidents to Planning Chairperson and/or President.

Unless otherwise noted, costs for all member's children (12 and under) for activities in which children are invited are paid by the Ministry's Children's Fund.
